ADMISSION PROCEDURE NOTICE 2019-20

Central University Common Entrance Test (CUCET) 2019 for admission to 5 years integrated M. Sc. in Economics course with an option to exit after 3 years will be held on 25th and 26th May 2019 and the result of CUCET will be announced on 21st of June 2019. The candidates of Karnataka and other states who have applied for admission to Bengaluru Dr. B.R. Ambedkar School of Economics (BASE), their merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in CUCET 2019 with eligibility of minimum marks of 65% for GM and OBC candidates (60% for SC/ST candidates) is must and should have studied English as one of the Language and Mathematics as one of the core subject in 2nd PUC /10+2/Equivalent Examination. The merit list prepared by BASE (on CUCET Score) will be published on the BASE website www.base.ac.in for the information of the candidates.

BASE will conduct the online seat selection process (Counselling) for admission to 1st year of 5 years integrated M.Sc. in Economics course with an option to exit after 3 years, for both Karnataka and other states candidates, on the basis of the merit list prepared by CUCET score with eligibility of minimum marks of 65% for GM and OBC candidates, (60% for SC/ST candidates) is must and should have studied English as one of the Language and Mathematics as one of the core subject in 2nd PUC /10+2/Equivalent Examination and also as per the reservation policy of Government of Karnataka.

Important information for Karnataka Candidates: -

- 1) Candidate who claims seats under Karnataka quota including reservation candidates have to submit the following original documents along with two sets of Xerox copies duly attested by Gazetted Officer and 2-passport size photos on the date and day of document verification notified in the calendar of Events of BASE.
 - a) Original SSLC marks card.
 - b) Original 2nd PUC/ 10+2/ Equivalent Examination marks card.
 - c) Original 7years study certificate including SSLC, PUC/ 10+2/Equivalent Examination from any recognised Institutions by the Government of Karnataka, counter signed by respective BEO.
 - d) Original Caste and Income certificate issued by Competent Authority (Tahsildar) for candidates who claims seats both under GM and in respective OBC category.
 - e) Original SC/ST certificates issued by competent authority in Karnataka for candidates who claims seats under both GM and SC/ST category.
 - f) Original Hyderabad-Karnataka certificate under 371 (J) from competent Authority for candidates who claims seat under Hyderabad-Karnataka 371(J) category.
 - g) Original Rural certificates and Kannada Medium certificates issued by competent authority for candidates who claim seats under Rural and Kannada Medium category.

- h) Original Physically Challenged certificate, Ex- Military Person, certificate issued by competent authority for candidates who claims seat under Physically Challenged and Ex- Military Person category.
- i) Candidates who claims seats only under general merit have to submit SSLC/10th and 2nd PUC/ 12th marks card along with 7years study certificate.

Important Information for candidates of all state including Karnataka.

- a) Candidates of all states including Karnataka who claims seats under GM category have to submit SSLC/10th and 2nd PUC/12th Standard original marks cards with two set of Xerox copies duly attested by Gazetted Officer on the date and day of document verification notified in the calendar of Events of BASE / on the day of admission.
- b) Candidates of all states including Karnataka who claims seats under SC/ST category have to submit SC/ST category certificate issued by competent Authority of your Taluka Jurisdiction.
- c) Candidates of all states including Karnataka, who claims seats under Physically Challenged and Ex- Military Person category, have to submit the certificates issued by competent authority.
- d) All the above documents have to be submitted in original along with two sets of Xerox copies duly attested by gazetted Officer and two passport size photos.
