Sir,

With reference to the letter No.BASE/79/2019 dated 02.11.2019 on the above subject, I am directed to say that Bengaluru Dr. B.R. Ambedkar School of Economics University, Rajaji Hall, Central College Campus, Bangalore University, Bengaluru – 560 001 Karnataka has been established by an Act No.20 of 2019 (published in Karnataka Gazette Extraordinary on 16.10.2019) of the State Legislature of Karnataka as a State University notified vide Notification No. ED 41 UBV 2018(P-2) Bengaluru dated 30.10.2019 and is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 at its own departments, its constituent colleges and/or through its affiliated colleges in regular mode with the approval of its statutory bodies/councils, wherever required. The name of the University has been included in the list of Universities established as per section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956, as main ained by the UGC on its website www.ugc.ac.in.

The University shall operate only within the territorial jurisdiction allotted to it under its Act and in no case beyond the territory of the State of its location. The University is not allowed to start any off-campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction as provided in the Act and under no circumstances beyond the State of its location, as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment in Prof. Yash Pal vs. State of Chhattisgarh case.

The University may note and adhere to the following: -

- (i) To ensure that no off campus centre(s)/study centre(s) is opened beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the University as stipulated in the Act and in no case beyond the territory of the State.
- (ii) To ensure that no programmes should be offered through franchising arrangement with private institutions.



- To ensure that no study centre(s) are opened through franchises by the University (iii)
- In case the university has already started any off-campus/study centre and the centre of franchises outside the State, it must be closed immediately. operating through franchises outside the State, it must be closed immediately. (iv)
- No distance education programmes shall be started without the prior $\mathsf{approv}_{\mathsf{al}}$, (v)
- M.Phil/Ph.D programmes can be conducted as per the provisions of UGC (Minimum (vi) Standards and Procedure for Awards of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2016. (vii)
- The University is required to follow all the UGC Regulations notified and available on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.
