## ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

BASE will conduct the online seat selection process (Counselling) for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year of 5 years integrated M.Sc. in Economics course with an option to exit after 3 years, for both Karnataka and other states candidates, on the basis of the merit list prepared by CUCET score with eligibility of minimum marks of 65% for GM and OBC candidates, (60% for SC/ST candidates) is must and should have studied English as one of the Language and Mathematics as one of the core subject in 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC /10+2/Equivalent Examination and also as per the reservation policy of Government of Karnataka.

BASE conduct document verification for candidates who claim seats under Karnataka quota.

### Important instruction for Karnataka Candidates for document verification:

Candidate who claims seats under Karnataka quota including reservation candidates have to submit the following original documents along with two sets of Xerox copies duly self-attested and 2-passport size photos, on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2019 at 10:30 am in person. Candidates who claims seat under General Merit have to submit the following document.

1. Original SSLC marks card.
2. Original 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/ 10+2/ Equivalent Examination marks card.
3. Original 7 years study certificate including SSLC, PUC/ 10+2/Equivalent Examination from any Government and Government recognised Institutions by Government Karnataka, counter signed by respective BEO along with two sets of self-attested photocopies.
4. Candidate who claims seat under OBC i.e., Category-1, 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B have to submit original Caste and Income Certificate issued by Competent Authority (Tahsildar) along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/ 12<sup>th</sup> marks card and 7years study certificate.
5. Candidate who claims seat under SC/ST Category have to submit SC/ST Caste Certificates issued by Tahsildar in Karnataka along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/ 12<sup>th</sup> marks card and 7years study certificate.
6. Candidate who claims seat under Hyderabad-Karnataka (under 371 (J)) have to submit Certificate under 371 (J) from competent Authority along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/ 12<sup>th</sup> marks card and 7years study certificate.
7. Candidate who claims seat under Rural Category have to submit Rural Certificates issued by competent authority along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/ 12<sup>th</sup> marks card and 7years study certificate.

8. Candidate who claims seat under Kannada Medium have to submit Kannada Medium Study certificates issued by competent authority along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/12<sup>th</sup> marks card and 7years study certificate.
9. Candidate who claims seat under Physically Challenged quota have to submit Physically Challenged Certificate from the notified Doctors along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/12<sup>th</sup> marks card and 7years study certificate.
10. Candidate who claims seat under Ex- Military Person quota have to submit Ex- Military Person certificate issued by notified officer along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/12<sup>th</sup> marks card and 7years study certificate.

Note: Seven years study certificate, Kannada Medium Certificate should be counter signed by respective Deputy Directors of Public Instructions, and Rural Certificate should be counter signed by Deputy Directors of Public Instructions and Tahsildar.


### Important Instructions for Document Verification of all States candidates.

1. Candidates who claims seats under All states quota have to upload the following required document on BASE website [www.base.ac.in](http://www.base.ac.in) on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019.
2. General Merit candidates have to upload SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/12<sup>th</sup> Standard marks cards.
3. Physically Handicapped candidates of all states have to upload Physically Handicapped Certificate issued by notified medical officer along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/12<sup>th</sup> Standard marks cards.
4. Ex- Serviceman candidates of all states have to upload Ex- Serviceman Certificate issued by notified officer along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/12<sup>th</sup> Standard marks cards.
5. SC/ST candidates of all states have to upload SC/ST Certificate issued by concerned Tahsildar along with SSLC/10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/12<sup>th</sup> Standard marks cards.

After uploading of the above said required document, BASE will verify the documents and publish the eligible list of candidates under all states candidates category.

BASE after verifying documents of both Karnataka and All states candidates will conduct the online seat selection on the basis of mark lists published by CUCET 2019.

The Process of online seat selection will publish on the website of BASE.
