Teaching Assistance guidelines

All the PhD candidates are expected to assist the faculty members at BASE University in academic activities to gain experience in teaching and research. This guideline is specific to those doctoral candidates who are not awarded any research fellowship.

Roles and responsibilities

The teaching assistant shall assist the Research Supervisor/and or other faculty member at BASE University whose subject area is related to the doctoral thesis topic of the candidate. The Doctoral committee shall recommend the subjects to be assigned based on request from faculty members.

The teaching assistant shall be assigned various academic tasks by the concerned faculty member/s which shall include class room teaching, collecting and organizing study/lecture material, assisting in lab sessions, evaluation of answer scrips, setting question papers, providing clarification to students, preparation for seminars etc.

Duration

All PhD scholars who have completed their coursework shall take up teaching assistance under faculty members in the University for a minimum period of one year and shall be extended up to three years based on the recommendation by the Doctoral Committee. A minimum of 12 hours shall be given for the teaching assistance job per week.

Remuneration

Those candidates who not avail any research fellowship shall be paid a consolidated amount of Rs. 20000 per month.

Termination

The University reserves the right to terminate the Teaching Assistantship on the ground of unsatisfactory report of the research work and other duties.
