## Notification

### **Admission to 2 year M.Sc. Economics [30 seats for Indian candidates + 5 seats for PIO/ FN] and 2 year M.Sc. Financial Economics [30 seats for Indian candidates + 5 seats for PIO/ FN] programme for the Academic year 2024-25 (for PG courses)**

#### **1. ELIGIBILITY:**

(a) **For All State Candidates other than Karnataka :**

Candidates should have completed B.Sc. (Honours)/B. A (Honours) in Economics or B.Sc./B.A in Economics with Mathematics and Statistics/Econometrics as major courses in the degree with minimum of 55% (50% for SC/ST) in aggregate.

(b) **For Karnataka Candidates under NEP 2020 scheme :**

i. Candidates should have completed B.Sc. (Honours)/B. A (Honours) in Economics with minimum of 55% (50% for SC/ST) in aggregate.

or

ii. Candidates should have completed B.Sc./B.A. Economics with at least 2 papers of Mathematics (for Economics) and 2 papers of Statistics (for Economics) / Econometrics with

Mathematics as a core subject in 2nd PUC/12th Standard/10+2/Equivalent examination with minimum of 55% (50% for SC/ST) in aggregate

#### **2. Selection Procedure**

(a) Based on performance in CUET-2024 (Common University Entrance Test) conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA) for 2-year M.Sc. Economics and 2-year M.Sc. Financial Economics Course as well as the University Admission advertisement 2024, Provisional merit list will be prepared based on marks secured in the entrance test of paper code no. COQP10 in CUET - 2024 (PG):

(b) For PIO/ Foreign Nationals admission is based on the merit list of the performance in the respective qualifying examination. Appearance for CUET-2024 is not compulsory.

(c) If any seats remain unfilled under 'Karnataka Category', such seats will be converted to 'All States including Karnataka Category' and vice-versa. While converting Karnataka category to All State category, first preference will be given to All State Candidates who have resided for not less than Ten years in Karnataka subject to producing domicile certificate.

### **3) Details of Admission Procedure.**

Admissions offered will be confirmed subject to physical verification of documents relating to eligibility criteria.

The following admission eligibility list will be prepared by the University on the basis of Online Entrance Test (CUET -PG) Score secured in question paper code COQP10 in CUET 2024, Eligibility criteria and as per the reservation roster. Merit list will be published on the University website [www.base.ac.in](http://www.base.ac.in).

- All States including Karnataka candidates merit list
- Karnataka candidate merit list
- Kalyana Karnataka (H-K / 371(J)) candidates merit list.

**Note:** 1. The admission will remain provisional until the physical verification of original documents indicating that the candidate has met the eligibility criteria.

2. In case the candidates do not indicate their acceptance within the stipulated deadline, the provisional offer stands cancelled.

3. If at any stage of the admission process, it is found that there is a discrepancy in the information provided by the candidate, the University reserves the right to cancel his / her candidature.

### **4) Instructions to Karnataka Candidates: -**

Candidates who got provisional admission under Karnataka quota including reservation category, have to produce the following documents at the time of verification.

- Original SSLC /10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/ 10+2/ Equivalent Examination marks cards and Original all semester marks card/Yearly marks of the UG courses.
- Original Degree Convocation /Provisional Degree Certificate.
- Original Transfer Certificate and Migration Certificate
- Original 7-year study certificate including SSLC/PUC/ 10+2/Equivalent Examination from Head of the Institutions.
- Candidates who claim seats under SC/ST/OBC (Cat-I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB), original Caste and Income Certificate issued by the Competent Authority (Tahsildar).
- Candidates who claim seats under **Hyderabad-Karnataka 371(J)** category, original certificate under 371 (J) issued by the Competent Authority.
- Candidates who claim seats under **Rural (1-10<sup>th</sup> standard)/ Kannada Medium (1-10<sup>th</sup> standard) / physically Challenged / Ex- Military Person category**, original certificates of respective category issued by the competent authority.
- CUET Score Card.
- 2 sets of copies of the all above documents (self attested).

- j) Recent 4 passport size photographs.
- k) Copy of Aadhar card.

**5) Instructions to the candidates of All States including Karnataka.**

Candidates of All States including Karnataka has to produce the following documents at the time of verification.

- a) Original SSLC /10<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/ 10+2/ Equivalent Examination marks cards and Original all semester marks card/Yearly marks of the UG courses.
- b) Original Degree Convocation /Provisional Degree Certificate.
- c) Original Transfer Certificate and Migration Certificate
- d) Candidates of all States including Karnataka who claim seats under SC/ST original Caste and Income Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- e) Candidates of all States including Karnataka who claim seats under / **physically Challenged / Ex- Military Person category** have to bring the original certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- f) As per rule 2(C) above, if any candidate is eligible to avail seat under conversion rule from All State Category to Karnataka based on their residence in Karnataka, they have to upload the 10 years Karnataka domicile certificate issued by the competent authority.
- g) CUET Score Card.
- h) 2 sets of copies of the all above documents (self-attested).
- i) Recent 4 passport size photographs.
- j) Copy of Aadhar card.
